Name: **Lola** (death) **Phoenix** (transformation/rebirth)

**Character Storyline:** Heavily influenced and based on “the death” oracle card.



The Death card is often misunderstood by those who interpret it too literally. It rarely refers to physical death; rather, it symbolizes the natural cycle of transformation and the necessity of clearing away the old to make space for the new. It signifies profound change, the ending of a major life cycle, and psychological rebirth.

## **Stark Attributes:**

- The conclusion of major life chapters
- Cycle of life
- Letting go of the past
- Transitioning
- Inevitable endings
- Clearing out the old, making room for the new

**Symbolism** (can be incorporated into different shots or used as props/costuming):

- **The Skeleton:** Represents the invincibility of change, it cannot be stopped or bargained with
- **The White Horse:** Symbolizes purification and the noble nature of transformation
- **The Rising Sun:** Represents hope and the promise that every ending leads to a new dawn
- **Boat or a River:** Symbolizes the transition of the soul or the journey from one state of being to another

**Backstory:** Lola grew up in a town so small it rarely changed, a place where familiarity felt safer than possibility. She rarely ventured beyond its borders, unsure whether her attachment was love or simply habit. Quiet and reserved, she kept the same two friends since childhood, relationships that endured more from routine than real connection.

Though she longed to be spontaneous, to leave everything behind and embrace the unknown, she never quite knew how. Instead, she remained stuck in a life that felt stagnant, aware of her unhappiness but unable to escape it.

On a sudden whim, Lola chose to attend university on the opposite side of the country, hoping distance might give her clarity and a clean slate. It was her first real step toward breaking old patterns, confronting discomfort, and becoming someone new.

**Archetype:**

***Reluctant Seeker and the Everywoman***

As the reluctant seeker, Lola is driven by quiet dissatisfaction. Her journey begins not because she wants to conquer the world, but because staying where she is has become unbearable. Change is frightening to her, yet stagnation is worse. This archetype is defined by internal conflict: the pull between safety and growth, familiarity and possibility. Lola is also deeply relatable. She represents the ordinary person who feels out of sync with her life, shaped by routine and expectation rather than desire. Her

strength isn't confidence or fearlessness, but awareness, the dawning realization that something has to change, even if she doesn't know what comes next.

- Simple
